## Important Information

### Baggage:

- ggage Allowance Domestic: Hand' Cabin baggage of maximum 7 for Economy (which would include Laptop and duty free shopping bags) having maximum over all dimensions of: 115 cms. (L+W+H) on Boeing 108 cms. (L+W+H) on Bombardier flights) handbag is allowed to be carried per passenger, free of cost. Passengers with infants are allowed to carry an additional piece of hand baggage of maximum 7 kg for Cahin Ba
- tilgins and 10s cms. (L+W+H) on bornearder flights, hardoog is allowed to be carried per passenger, free or cost. Passengers with infants are allowed to carry an adoutoral prece or hand baggage of maximum / ig for Economy, to exceeding the size dimensions, as mentioned herein before.

  2. Cabin Baggage Allowence International: International: Hand Cabin baggage of maximum / ig for Economy, which would include Laptop and dutyfree shopping bags), having maximum over all dimensions of: 108 cms.

  (L+W+H) on Bornearder flights, and 115 cms. (L+W+H) on Boeing flights is allowed to be carried per passenger, free of cost. Passengers with infants are allowed to carry an additional piece of hand baggage of maximum / ig for Economy, not exceeding the size dimensions, as mentioned herein before.

  3. Checked-in Baggage Allowence: For Domestic International travel, baggage allowence of 20 lig (30 lig in case passenger is travelling toffrom.) Edoth in case the passenger is travelling toffrom. Jedoth and Riyadh, baggage allowence of 30 lig is allowed. Please note that in case the passenger is travelling toffrom. Jedoth bindia and the baggage allowence is 30 lig then along with it, 5 liters of Zam Zamwater (orly) will be accepted over and above the baggage allowence. For passengers travelling toffrom/Asul for the period 11th Ferbruary- 28th March, 2020, baggage allowence will be permitted. For passengers travelling between Chemnai-Colombo-Chemnai for the period 1st 3 lst March, 2020, baggage allowence will be 40 lig., post 3 lst March, 2020, only 30 lg of baggage allowance will be permitted.

  4. Passenger travelling on SpiceJet domestic sector to SpiceJet international sector or vice versa the Free Baggage Allowance of International sector will be applicable once within 24hrs of its flight departure to any domestic sector after landing in India.
- 5. Passenger travelling on SpiceJet domestic Sector and having connection on another airline to/from an international destination, are allowed Free Baggage Allowance of 15 kgs per passenger per flight. (W.e.f 4th Nov,2014)

## Check-In:

- 6. Domestic: Airport check in counters will open two hours prior to the scheduled departure time. Passengers are encouraged to report at the Airport between 1-2 hours prior to the scheduled departure time. Check in counters for all our flights will close 45 minutes prior to departure for Economy class Passengers. International: Airport check-in counters will open 3 hours prior to the scheduled departure time. Check in counters for all flights will close 60 minutes in case of Dubai and Kabul) prior to departure.

Passengers doing web check-in shall be responsible for ensuring their hand-baggage meets the physical dimension limits the weight limits, and must pay for excess cabin baggage (if any) at the airport check-in counter. There will be random check-at boarding gates for hand baggage size and weight, and if found oversized or overweight, INR 400′ Kg (effective from 22nd June, 2018) will be chargeable, and additionally the bag may be taken from the passenger to be placed in the hold.

## Payment by foreign credit cards:

9. For all foreign (Non-Indian) credit / debit card payments, the card must be produced for physical verification at the airport check-in counter if the passenger is the cardholder. Incase the cardholder is not traveling, it is mandatory for the passenger to furnish to the airport check-in staff a physical copy of the front side of credit / debit card duly authorized by the cardholder, along with cardholder's valid proof of identification. In the absence of such credit / debit card or copy and/or identify mismatch, we will be constrained to refuse the boarding. You may however pay through acceptable alternate mode of payment at the time of check-in and continue your journey.

Cancellations and Rescheduling Initiated by Passengers:

10. Charges/cancellation in the bookings can be made only up to 2 hour prior to scheduled departure time (4 hours in case of international travel) upon payment of a charges/cancellation fee (amount depends on the type of far e purchased, as advised at the time of booking) along with difference in fare, if applicable.
